DESIGN IN DETAIL

CHALLENGE

To create a kitchen ready for entertaining.

SOLUTION

By replacing the walk-in pantry with a wall of pantry cabinets, we gained the space to create the large island that easily sits 6 guests. The new kitchen feels twice the size and really works for this active family!



- 01** The large island houses the cooktop, boasts a round bullnose end and has lots of room for 6+ stools.
- 02** The Murano glass exhaust hood is decorative and functional.
- 03** The cabinets are made from aged grain white ash and have a painted and glazed finish.
- 04** Open shelves over the sink provide display space for accessories.
- 05** The marble backsplash compliments the dark quartz counter tops.
- 06** The window seat fills the space once used by the dinette table and allows for lounging.
- 07** The adjustable, swivel barstools provide a perfect place to hang out and keep the cook company!
- 08** The engineered brushed oak hardwood floors are finished with a white glaze and are the ideal colour to hide dust.
- 09** The ceiling, painted a lighter shade of the wall colour, provides a soft contrast to the cream distressed cabinets.
- 10** All the original cherry stained oak trims were painted to create a lighter feel.
- 11** The fridge was moved from previous location where it just didn't work.
- 12** The wall of pantry cabinets easily replaces all the storage of the old walk-in pantry.
- 13** The shallow accent cabinet becomes control central and houses everyone's calendars, the phone chargers, cook books, storage drawers for phone books, pens & paper, plus a place for a few collectables.
- 14** End of island houses the recycling pull-out making it easy to access.
